








New Residence Halls

Two New Residence Halls at Amherst College are the first buildings of our firm's master plan for a new East Campus residential Quad. These buildings, housing 115 students, frame a major opening between existing residential buildings and the College's athletic fields:

- Strong, simple forms recall the elemental character of typical Amherst buildings
- A shallow curve gives the buildings' edge a dynamic quality and opens the East Campus Quad to the greater landscape
- Carved into the base of each building, large ground floor lounges organize the life of each building around stone hearths and continuous views to campus.
